

Minutes of the Troy Township Public Hearing
Monday, April 16, 2018
7:00 pm

Troy Township Public Hearing held at the Troy Township Community Center, 25448 Seil Road, Shorewood, Illinois.

Supervisor Joseph D. Baltz called the meeting to order. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and lead by Trustee Larry Ryan.

Supervisor Baltz stated that this is a public hearing for the fiscal year 2018-2019 Road District budget and appropriation ordinance 18-19-01 and for fiscal year 2018-2019 Township budget and appropriation ordinance 18-19-02.

Supervisor Baltz asked for any citizen comments.

After asking two more times the meeting was closed for citizen comments.

Supervisor Baltz opened the meeting for review of the Road and Bridge budget and appropriation ordinance 18-19-01. Administrator Dylík asked if she could make a few comments addressing both the Road and Bridge budget and the Township budget.

Dylík stated that the budgets presented here tonight have not changed from those reviewed at the Finance Committee meeting except for the starting cash balance which would be the ending cash balance from the fiscal year which ended on March 31, 2018.

Dylík reported that from what was presented at the March 19th finance committee meeting, the starting cash balance as of April 1, 2018 for each fund has increased as follows:

- Town Fund – From \$590,292.56 to \$595,305.59; \$5,013.03
- GA Fund – from \$32,437.44 to \$32,488.02; \$50.58
- R&B Fund – from \$774,647.12 to \$780,272.64; \$5,625.52

The budgets presented for approval tonight have been on display on the website and at the building since February 20, 2018.

Dylík thanked everyone that took the time to help develop, review, comment, and question the 2018-2019 fiscal year budgets. She is very proud of the budgets that were prepared. She is also proud of the fact that the budgets are conservative in nature, that consideration is always given to spending taxpayer dollars wisely, that it is a collaborative effort amongst department heads, elected officials, and staff, and that the budget presentation is used as a communication tool for not only the Township board but more importantly for the residents of Troy

Township. With no questions having been brought forward since the finance committee on March 19th she respectfully requested that the Troy Township board approve both budgets as presented here tonight.

Supervisor Baltz asked for any questions about the budgets or of Administrator Dylik.

Trustee Ryan, Chairman of the Finance Committee, complimented Administrator Dylik on the budget proposal. The detail and history provided in the proposal allows the board to use that document and information provided to help guide the vision of the township which then allows for proper planning of capital improvement projects, vehicle purchases, etc.

Supervisor Baltz asked again for any questions or comments on either budget.

Supervisor Baltz asked for a motion to approve Ordinance 18-19-01.

Motion made by Trustee Ryan; seconded by Trustee Wheeler to adopt Ordinance 18-19-01 an Ordinance Appropriating for all Road Purposes for Troy Road District, Will County, Illinois, for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 2018, and ending March 31, 2019. Roll call vote: Kopman – Aye; Ryan–Aye; Theobald–Absent; Wheeler–Aye; Baltz–Aye. 4 Ayes, 0 Nays, 1 Absent. Motion Carried.


Supervisor Baltz asked for any questions about Ordinance 18-19-02. Hearing none he requested a motion to approve.

Motion made by Trustee Kopman; seconded by Trustee Wheeler to adopt Ordinance 18-19-02 an Ordinance Appropriating for all Town Purposes and General Assistance for Troy Township, Will County, Illinois, for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 2018, and ending March 31, 2019. Roll call vote: Kopman – Aye; Ryan–Aye; Theobald–Absent; Wheeler–Aye; Baltz–Aye. 4 Ayes, 0 Nays, 1 Absent. Motion Carried.

Supervisor Baltz asked for any further discussion. No further discussion was brought forward.

Motion made by Trustee Ryan; seconded by Trustee Wheeler to adjourn. Roll call vote: Kopman – Aye; Ryan–Aye; Theobald–Absent; Wheeler–Aye; Baltz–Aye. 4 Ayes, 0 Nays, 1 Absent. Motion Carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:07pm.
