## Troy Township Seniors Code of Conduct Policy

For the safety and benefit of all participants, the following Code of Conduct Policy will be observed.

### Code of Conduct Policy

- 1) Participants in Troy Township Seniors activities shall:
  - a) Treat other participants and staff respectfully and courteously.
  - b) Treat others in the same manner you would like to be treated.
  - c) Welcome new members or visitors to your table.
- 2) Behavior that constitutes a violation of this policy include:
  - a) Loud, disruptive, obscene, hateful, or abusive language.
  - b) Making threats or demonstrating threatening behavior, verbally or in writing, to participants, guests, or staff.
  - c) Violation of smoking laws inside and outside of the building.
  - d) Defacing or destroying any Township property.
  - e) Lack of personal cleanliness and proper hygiene.
  - f) Activities that negatively affect the health of others.
  - g) Racial, religious, political, or sexual harassment of participants or staff.
  - h) Physical altercations with participants, guests, or staff.
  - i) Removal of Troy Township or Troy Township Seniors property without permission.
  - j) Participating in activities while under the adverse influence of alcohol or drugs.
  - k) Committing or attempting to commit any activity that would constitute a violation of any federal, state, or local criminal statute ordinance.
  - l) Other behavior that is deemed inappropriate by the Community Services Director.

### Consequences of Policy Violation

Violation(s) of this policy may result in the suspension of participant(s) from Troy Township Seniors activities.
