

EXEMPTION EVENT AT TROY TOWNSHIP

TUESDAY, MAY 10TH FROM 9:00 A.M.—3:00 P.M.

The Exemption Event is for both renewal applicants and first-time applicants.

This is a walk-in event, no appointments accepted.

If you receive a renewal application in the mail – PLEASE bring it with you as applications will be limited.

For all exemptions, you MUST be the principal owner of your property and be responsible for the payment of property taxes.

Documents to bring with you:
