The Referendum Alternative

One Troy, One Hauler Program

With voter approval, Troy Township will contract with a single hauler for refuse, recycling, applicance, and bulk goods collection along with an option for yard waste.

Contract awarded through a competitive bidding process.

Lowest responsible bidder selected.

Residents will have individual accounts with selected vendor for payment of services.

- Available to all homes in unincorporated Troy Township.
- Weekly refuse collection 95-gallon cart provided.
- ✓ Weekly recycling –95-gallon cart provided.
- ✓ One (1) appliance collected weekly.
- ✓ One (1) bulk item collected weekly.
- ✓ Yard waste pickup (April 1 Nov 30)

- **✓** Opt-out available, provisions apply.
- Less truck traffic on unincorporated
